





Flight Training Devices evolution enable us to offload many training hours from a Full Flight Simulator, in all phases of a pilot training

Objectives:


- a) To become an advisory group to the LATAM/CAR region, under the leadership of ICAO, in matters related to Aircrew Training, to guarantee that the region is always up to date in matters related to Aircrew training, and that regulations are updated accordingly, providing guidance to civil aviation authorities in the definition of such regulations
- b) Analyse the common needs and requirements that flight simulators can offer in expediting pilot and aviation training
- c) Develop model regulations and guidance material for the States to adopt

Deliverables for Phase 1 are due June 2023

Our target: To adopt guidance material from ICAO Doc 9625



Project Phases



Deliverables from Conclusion NACC/DCA/10/9 (Phase 1):

- a) Deliverable 1: Develop a guidance document on a harmonized approach, to amend national regulations and procedures to make use of flight simulation as a valid tool/media for pilot training
- a) Deliverable 2: To identify and present good practices and lessons learned of similar deployments, to include them as part of the guidance


