Objectives:

- To become an advisory group to the LATAM/CAR region, under the leadership of ICAO, in matters related to Aircrew Training, to guarantee that the region is always up to date in matters related to Aircrew training, and that regulations are updated accordingly, providing guidance to civil aviation authorities in the definition of such regulations
- Analyse the common needs and requirements that flight simulators can offer in expediting pilot and aviation training
- Develop model regulations and guidance material for the States to adopt

























- Agreement with 13 partners already enrolled.
