

Implementation of Competency-based training

- EBT/CBTA working group composed of 9 airlines and 1 flight academy
- Working group agreed to:
 - Invite ICAO, EASA, FAA, Boeing, Airbus and expert Authorities as Brazil, Panama and Colombia, as members of the WG
 - Develop a single regional workshop for EBT/CBTA in Brazil, including the target countries of implementation: Peru, Chile and Argentina. Workshop to be hosted by LATAM, March 20-21st in Sao Paulo
 - Review Flybondi's offer from Salient to perform instructor's training and implementation services and check viability for the region

- Enhanced Operational Flexibility and Efficiency
